Extract from the Standing Orders of the Council of Benchers of Lincoln's Inn

Nominations

- 35 A member of the Society may (if eligible) be nominated for election as an ordinary bencher by a letter
 - (a) addressed to the Under Treasurer, and
 - (b) signed by 5 or more members of the Society each of whom is either an ordinary bencher or a member of at least 5 years call.
- 36 (1) A nomination is invalid unless it reaches the Treasury Office before 1700 hours on the closing date for nominations fixed by the Treasurer as required by clause 32.
 - (2) A nomination is invalid unless
 - (a) it includes a written statement by at least one of the nominators regarding the nominee's suitability to be a bencher, and
 - (b) the statement includes an indication that the nominators believe that, if elected as a bencher, the nominee would be able and willing to do work for the Society and take part in its governance (either generally or with regard to a particular aspect).
 - (3) A nomination is valid only for the purposes of the first election of ordinary benchers held after its receipt by the Under Treasurer.
 - (4) But a member may be re-nominated, without limit on the number of times.
- 37 (1) If the Under Treasurer receives a valid nomination he or she must forward it as soon as practicable to the advisory (benchers) committee for the committee's consideration.
 - (2) The nominators are responsible for supplying the committee with the information about the nominee which the committee needs to enable it to perform its functions relating to the nominee.
