What are Christians celebrating?

Death is not the last word. On Good Friday Christians stand by the cross and face Jesus' death. Three days later on Easter morning, the mood is quite different. Churches resound with trumpets and cries of 'Alleluia, Christ is Risen!' Often a special Easter Candle reminds us of the light of Christ, offering new hope.

The candle is for the whole year. It is lit at christenings at the start of the Christian journey: and for funerals as the earthly journey ends. It is the guiding light to lead us on and the night light to reassure us when life seems dark and difficult. It beckons us out of our complacency and fear to hope and dream once more, like this prayer of Sir Francis Drake:

Disturb us, Lord, when we are too well pleased with ourselves, When our dreams have come true because we have dreamed too little, When we arrived safely because we sailed too close to the shore. Disturb us, Lord, to dare more boldly, To venture on wider seas where storms will show your mastery; Where losing sight of land, we shall find the stars.

Love is the last word and where it all ends.

This is our hope and why here at the Inn we light candles at every service and give a special baptism candle to those being christened. For Easter encourages us to hope and dream – to enjoy the gift of life. Do come and join in our celebrations this term. Do join in our celebrations and look out for the special events in Chapel; for the Warburton Lecture; for Family Day; and for the baptisms, weddings and memorial services.
