# Catalogue Guide

## Textbooks

The catalogue record for textbooks primarily about Australian law should include *Australia* as a subject, so include this term in the *subject* field.

To search for the latest editions of textbooks, change the *type* field to *Latest edition held*. To search for old editions of textbooks, change the *type* field to *Old edition*.

## Legislation

The author of legislation will be the relevant jurisdiction, so include *Australia* in the *author* search field. Or, if you are looking for regional (state and territory) legislation, use the relevant name, e.g. New South Wales.

Change the *type* field to *Legislation*.

## Law Reports & Journals

The catalogue record for Australian serials (Law Reports & Journals) should include *Australia* as a subject, so include this term in the *subject* field.

Change the *type* field to *Journals* or *Law reports* as required, or search for a specific title in the *periodical title* field.

## Online Resources

A URL link will be available on catalogue records for Australian material available on LexisLibrary. Include *LexisLibrary* in the *words or phrases* search field to identify these titles. N.B. Not all titles available on LexisLibrary will be included on the catalogue.

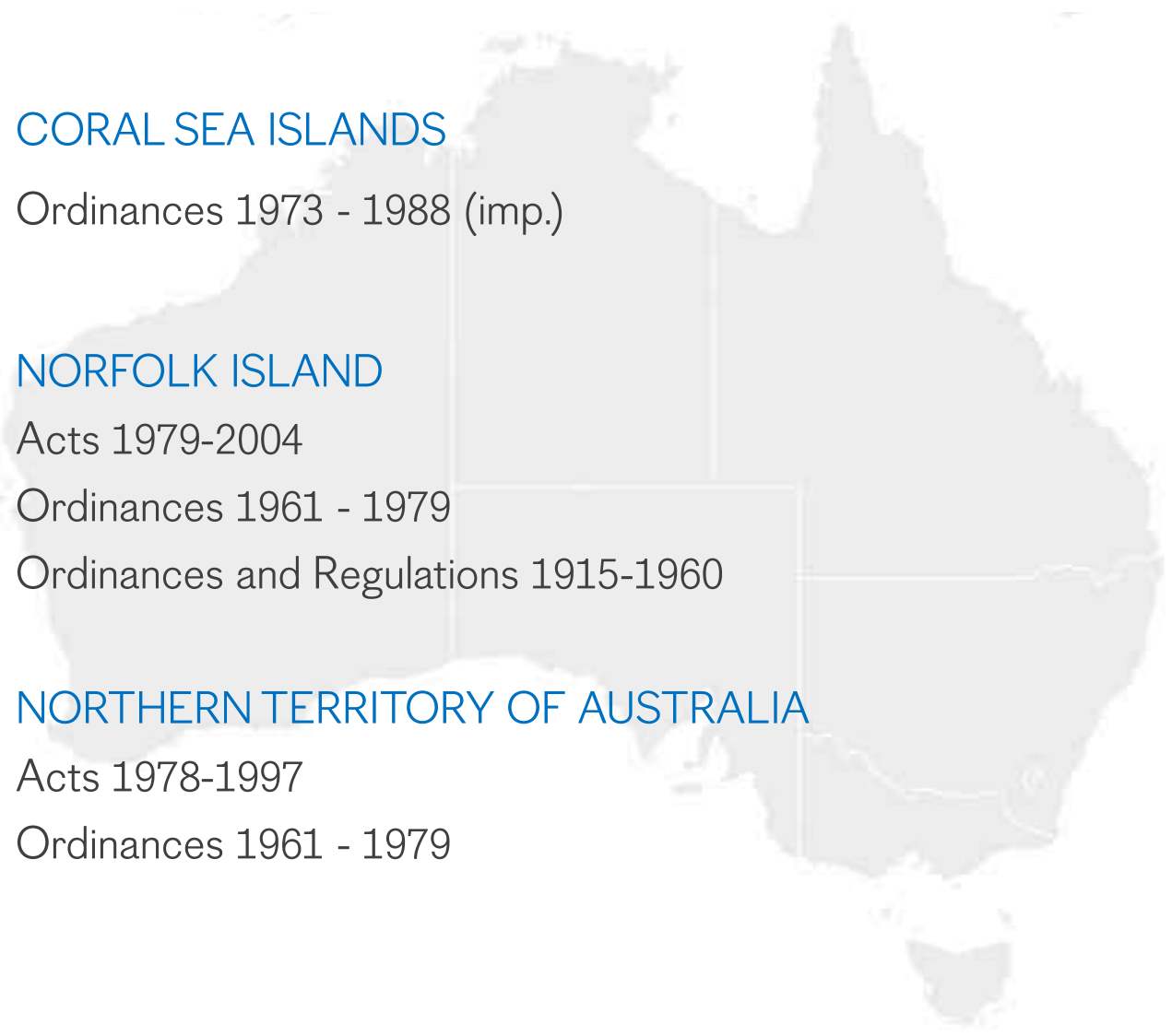

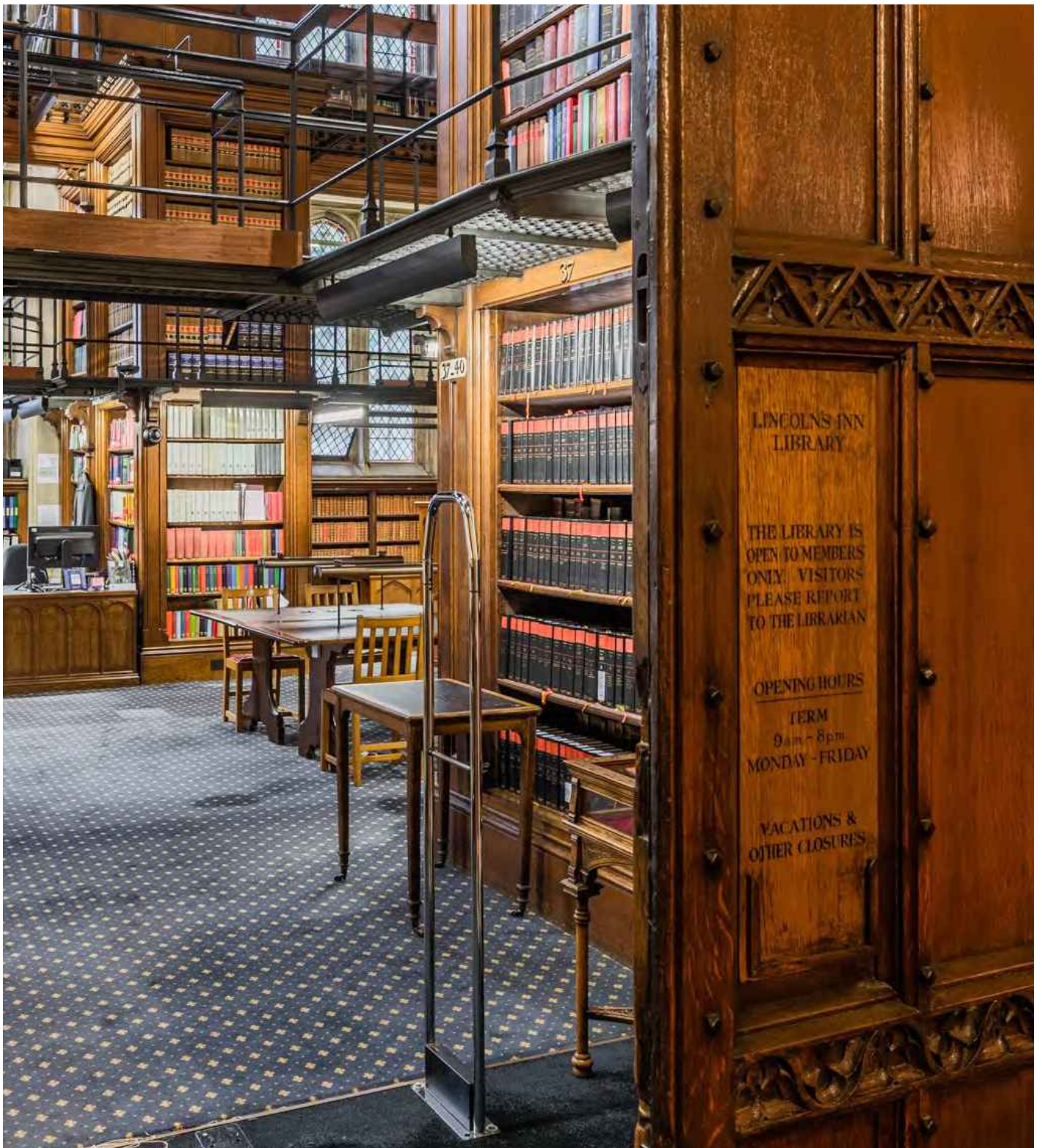
